14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Section 16-13-233, Code of Alabama 1975,
16	is amended to read as follows:
17	"§16-13-233.
18	"(a) The allowance for transportation for those
19	local boards of education providing same shall be determined
20	as follows for any local board of education: The number of
21	pupils transported on transportation routes approved under
22	regulations of the State Board of Education shall be
23	multiplied by an amount per pupil which is to be fixed by the
24	State Board of Education and applied to local boards of
25	education within groups having similar density of population;
26	provided, that studies shall be made from time to time to
27	determine whether the cost allowed per pupil or the cost unit

should be changed in any or all local boards of education. In 1 2 determining the amount to be allotted for transportation, said allotment shall include an allowance for transportation in 3 accordance with the provisions of Section 16-39-11; however, 4 5 no allowance shall be made for transporting pupils who live 6 less than two miles from the school they are attending unless 7 such pupils can be shown to be disabled and require 8 transportation. Upon a petition to the State Superintendent of 9 Education by the local board of education, the two mile limit 10 may be waived by the State Superintendent of Education to protect the safety of the children. At a minimum, the state 11 allocation for each bus shall be no less than the total fiscal 12 13 year 2019 amount. The total amount allotted any local board of education for transportation shall not exceed a figure 14 15 determined by the State Board of Education in terms of the ratio between pupils transported to school and the total 16 17 number of pupils attending school in the jurisdiction of such 18 local board of education or some similar ratio established by the State Board of Education. Any local board of education 19 20 which qualifies for a transportation allowance must provide 21 buses which meet minimum standards established by the State 22 Board of Education and must take such other steps to protect 23 the safety of the children as are required under regulations 24 of the State Board of Education.

"(b) The Notwithstanding any other provisions of law
to the contrary, the allowance for transportation provided in
subsection (a) above shall include funding for depreciation

1 based on a depreciation schedule established provided by the 2 State Board of Education for a maximum of 200,000 travel miles. The depreciation funding included in the transportation 3 allowance shall be set aside in a restricted fund by the local 4 5 boards of education for fleet renewal only and shall not be used for operating costs. These transportation cost allowance 6 7 depreciation funds shall not revert to the Education Trust Fund but shall be carried forward from fiscal year to fiscal 8 9 year to renew the transportation fleet of the local boards of 10 education.

"(c) This act adding this amendatory language shall only apply to buses that are 10 years old or newer and that have less than 200,000 travel miles as of the effective date of the act adding this amendatory language.

15 "(d) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this 16 section, the Alabama State Department of Education shall 17 adjust allowances for fleet renewal to a local board of 18 education so that the local board of education shall receive 19 70% of the per-bus fleet renewal allocation for any bus that 20 is paid off, and any excess fleet renewal funding shall revert 21 to the Education Trust Fund.

"(e) The Alabama State Board of Education shall
adopt rules to implement the depreciation schedule provided
for in subsection (b)."

25 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 26 first day of the third month following its passage and 27 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
