13 Relating to the Town of Louisville in Barbour
14 County; authorizing the sale of certain alcoholic beverages in
15 the town on Sundays under certain conditions.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. This act applies only in the Town of
18 Louisville in Barbour County.

19 Section 2. The sale of alcoholic beverages after
20 1:00 p.m. on Sundays may be authorized by the town council
21 within the corporate limits of the Town of Louisville as
22 provided in this act. The town council, by ordinance, may
23 regulate and permit the sale and consumption of alcoholic
24 beverages on Sunday after 1:00 p.m. as determined by the town
25 council by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic
26 Beverage Control Board. Pursuant to this authority, the town
27 council may regulate which retail licensees may sell alcoholic

1 beverages on Sunday, whether the sale may be for off-premises
2 consumption, and any other aspect of the Sunday sale of
3 alcoholic beverages.

4 Section 3. This act shall become effective
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
