13 Relating to the City of Union Springs in Bullock
14 County; to authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages for
15 off-premises consumption during certain hours on Sunday by
16 properly licensed retail licensees; and to provide for a
17 referendum.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Subject to approval at a referendum held
20 pursuant to Section 2, the sale of alcoholic beverages for
21 off-premises consumption after 1:00 p.m. on Sundays is
22 authorized within the city limits of Union Springs by properly
23 licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control
24 Board.

25 Section 2. (a) The City Council of the City of Union
26 Springs shall hold a referendum to determine if alcoholic
27 beverages for off-premises consumption may be sold after 1:00

1 p.m. on Sundays. The referendum shall be held at the next
2 general election held in the city. Costs of the referendum
3 shall be paid by the city. If a majority of the electors
4 voting thereon vote in favor of the question, then the sale of
5 alcoholic beverages after 1:00 p.m. on Sundays shall be
6 authorized. A second or subsequent referendum may not be held
7 within 12 months following a referendum that fails to be
8 approved.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
