17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Section 2 of Act 2017-65 of the 2017
19	Regular Session, now appearing as Section 45-14-244.07 of the
20	Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:
21	"\$45-14-244.07.
22	"(a) The proceeds from the tobacco tax authorized in
23	Clay County pursuant to Section 45-14-244, and as further
24	provided for in Sections 45-14-244.01 to 45-14-244.03,
25	inclusive, and Section 45-14-244.06, less two percent of the
26	actual cost of collection, which shall be retained by the

Department of Revenue, shall be distributed to the Clay County
 General Fund to be expended as follows:

3 "(1) Thirty-two percent to the Alabama Forestry
4 Commission to be utilized for fire protection in the county,
5 as provided in subsection (b).

6 "(2) Twenty percent to the Clay County Industrial 7 Development Council.

8 "(3) Eighteen <u>Twenty</u> percent to the Clay County 9 Animal Shelter. The Clay County Animal Shelter shall annually 10 report to the county commission regarding the expenditure of 11 the funds in the preceding year.

"(4) Fifteen Thirteen percent to the Clay County 12 13 Commission to be deposited into a special fund in the county treasury and, subject to an application process developed by 14 15 the county commission, disbursed to water districts in the county for the purpose of installing feeder lines. The county 16 17 commission shall have the authority to develop guidelines, 18 promulgate rules, and institute an application process to provide for the disbursement of the funds. 19

"(5) Fifteen percent shall be retained in the Clay
County General Fund to be utilized as are other county funds.

"(b) The funds distributed to the Alabama Forestry Commission shall be payable on a quarterly or monthly basis and will be expended solely for purposes of fire protection, prevention, and fire safety education in order to encourage a strong volunteer firefighters' network in Clay County. The proceeds shall be distributed to volunteer fire departments in

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the county as determined by rules and regulations set up by 1 the Alabama Forestry Commission and the Clay County Volunteer 2 Firefighters Association on an equal basis, share and share 3 alike. None of the proceeds shall be used for salaries nor to 4 5 pay members for any performance of duties associated with the 6 department. Any member fire department which fails to meet the 7 standards and criteria shall be denied its share of the funding. The association shall give noncomplying member fire 8 departments proper notice of all deficiencies and a reasonable 9 10 time period to correct the deficiencies before any funds are 11 denied."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on
 October 1, 2017.
