8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a local amendment to
9 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to
10 Madison County and the areas outside of the
11 corporate limits of any municipality, to authorize
12 the Madison County Commission to adopt and enforce
13 ordinances or resolutions to limit and restrict
14 noise levels and public nuisances caused by
15 excessive noise levels, and would authorize
16 criminal penalties.

18 A BILL
19 TO BE ENTITLED

22 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
23 Alabama of 1901, relating only to the areas of Madison County
24 outside of the corporate limits of any municipality, to
25 authorize the Madison County Commission to adopt and enforce
26 ordinances or resolutions to limit and restrict noise levels

1 and public nuisances caused by excessive noise levels; and to
2 authorize criminal penalties for violations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. The following amendment to the
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
6 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
7 this act are fulfilled:

8 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 (a) This amendment shall apply only to portions of
10 Madison County outside the corporate limits of any
11 municipality.

12 (b) The purpose of this amendment is to protect and
13 to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens
14 of Madison County, and to promote commerce, property
15 enjoyment, quality of life, and quality of the environment by
16 authorizing the Madison County Commission to adopt, amend, and
17 enforce ordinances or resolutions to limit noise levels and to
18 regulate public nuisances caused by noise levels in order to
19 minimize the exposure of its citizens to the physiological and
20 psychological dangers of excess noise.

21 (c) The Madison County Commission may adopt and
22 amend ordinances or resolutions applicable in the
23 unincorporated areas of Madison County to prohibit excessive
24 noise; to regulate, limit, and control noise levels; to
25 control public nuisances caused by excessive noise levels; and
26 to provide criminal penalties for violations. These ordinances
27 and resolutions shall be enforceable in any court of competent

1 jurisdiction within the county. Notwithstanding the foregoing,
2 no ordinance or resolution may be adopted to restrict noise
3 produced in the ordinary course of business by industrial
4 manufacturing, or farming facilities or activities.

5 (d) The Madison County Commission may provide
6 criminal penalties for violation of the ordinance or
7 resolution adopted pursuant to this amendment not to exceed
8 the penalties for a Class C misdemeanor.

9 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
10 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of
11 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections
12 284 and 284.01 of the Official ReCompilation of the
13 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election
14 laws of this state.

15 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
16 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
17 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
18 following description of the substance or subject matter of
19 the proposed constitutional amendment:

20 "Relating to Madison County and the areas outside
21 the corporate limits of any municipality, proposing an
22 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize
23 the county commission to adopt ordinances or resolutions to
24 prohibit excess noise, to regulate, limit, and control excess
25 noise levels, and to control public nuisance caused by excess
26 noise levels in the unincorporated areas of Madison County and

1 to authorize penalties not to exceed the penalties for a Class
2 C misdemeanor."

3 "Proposed by Act _____."

4 This description shall be followed by the following
5 language:

6 "Yes () No ()."
