PROPOSED AMENDMENT

8 "Section 65.

"Part I.

"Except as provided in Part II, the The legislature shall have no power to authorize lotteries or gift enterprises for any purposes, and shall pass laws to prohibit the sale in this state of lottery or gift enterprise tickets, or tickets in any scheme in the nature of a lottery; and, except as provided in Part II, all acts, or parts of acts heretofore passed by the legislature of this state, authorizing a lottery or lotteries, and all acts amendatory thereof, or supplemental thereto, are hereby avoided.

"Part II.

"Section 1. Declarations. The Legislature finds that lotteries have been enacted in many states and the revenues generated from those lotteries have contributed to the benefit of those states. Many Alabamians already participate in other state lotteries. Therefore, the purpose of the proposed amendment is to establish and provide for a lottery to generate revenue for the Education Trust Fund and the State General Fund.

1	"Section 2. Establishment of an Alabama Lottery.
2	"(a) The Legislature, by general law, shall provide
3	for the establishment, administration, operation, and
4	regulation of an Alabama Lottery consistent with this part.
5	"(b) The proceeds from the Alabama Lottery shall be
6	applied first to the payment of the expenses of administering
7	and operating the lottery, including, without limitation, the
