evidence is received by a law enforcement agency, the

Department of Forensic Sciences, or any other accredited
forensic laboratory, provided that sufficient staffing and
resources are available to do so.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
