1	(d) Fees from the fund may be disbursed at the
2	discretion of the judge of probate for records retention and
3	archiving, records reconstruction, records preservation,

6	equipment, and for the protection of records from
7	environmental decay and damage.

- (e) All fees in the fund shall be audited by the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts in the same manner as other funds.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
