10 esteemed resident of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, for

13 upon his distinguished service as a cadet with the Civil Air
14 Patrol on his 13th Birthday on October 25, 1943; he

18 by himself; and

19 WHEREAS, at age 90, Lieutenant Colonel Robert J.

22 young, aspiring Civil Air Patrol members; he took Eric Boe, an
23 accomplished astronaut and Civil Air Patrol member, on his
24 first airplane ride; in turn, Eric Boe invited him to Florida
25 for one of his shuttle launches; and

1 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Colonel Robert J. Haver is one
2 of the many pioneers of Civil Air Patrol who was influential
3 in making it the success it is today; notably, he received the
4 Congressional Gold Medal for his 70 years of commitment to
5 this great nation and to Civil Air Patrol; and

6 WHEREAS, through the years, Lieutenant Robert J.
7 Haver has earned widespread respect for the commitment and
8 capability he brought to every challenge while compiling an
9 outstanding record of leadership; now therefore,

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
11 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Lieutenant Colonel Robert J.
12 Haver is commended for extraordinary service to the Civil Air
