BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 11-46-38, Code of Alabama 1975,
9 is amended to read as follows:

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"§11-46-38.

"(a) At all municipal elections, the <u>a qualified</u> elector <u>must may</u> vote only in the ward or precinct of his or her residence where he or she is registered to vote <del>and at the</del> box or voting machine to which he or she has been assigned.

15 "(b) No person An individual may not vote at any 16 municipal election unless he or she is a registered and 17 qualified elector of the State of Alabama, who has resided in 18 the county 30 days and in the ward 30 days prior to the election, and who has registered not less than 10 days prior 19 to the date of the election at which he or she offers to vote 20 21 to vote in conformance with the time frame set forth in Section 17-3-50; provided, however, that any elector who, 22 23 within 30 days next preceding the date of the election at 24 which he or she offers to vote, has removed if a qualified 25 elector relocates his or her residence from one ward to

1 another ward in the same city or town within the 30-day period prior to the election, the elector shall have the right to 2 3 vote in the ward from which he or she has removed, where the elector had previously resided if he or she would have been 4 5 entitled to vote in the that ward but for such removal 6 relocating to the new ward. If any elector attempts to vote in 7 any ward other than that of his or her residence, except as hereinabove authorized, his or her vote must be rejected. 8 9 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict

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13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
