27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALARAMA.

Section 1. (a) There is appropriated the sum of \$14,730,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the State Board of Education for the purpose of funding the creation and maintenance of an anti-bullying program on each public K-12 school campus physically located in the state, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020.

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(b) During the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, the State Board of Education shall allocate \$10,000 of the above appropriation to each public K-12 school described in subsection (a), pursuant to a schedule developed by the board. The allocation shall be used by each school to establish and maintain an anti-bullying program on the school campus that is consistent with state law and any criteria adopted by the board.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
