8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would make an appropriation from
9 the Education Trust Fund to the State Board of
10 Education in the amount of \$14,730,000 for the
11 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, and would
12 require the board to allocate \$10,000 of that
13 amount to each public K-12 school in the state for
14 the purpose of establishing and maintaining an
15 anti-bullying program on each school campus.

21 To make an appropriation of \$14,730,000 from the
22 Education Trust Fund to the State Board of Education for the
23 fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, and to require the
24 board to allocate \$10,000 of that amount to each public K-12
25 school in the state for the purpose of establishing and
26 maintaining an anti-bullying program on each school campus.
27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. (a) There is appropriated the sum of
2 \$14,730,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the State Board
3 of Education for the purpose of funding the creation and
4 maintenance of an anti-bullying program on each public K-12
5 school campus physically located in the state, for the fiscal
6 year ending September 30, 2020.

7 (b) During the fiscal year ending September 30,
8 2020, the State Board of Education shall allocate \$10,000 of
9 the above appropriation to each public K-12 school described
10 in subsection (a), pursuant to a schedule developed by the
11 board. The allocation shall be used by each school to
12 establish and maintain an anti-bullying program on the school
13 campus that is consistent with state law and any criteria
14 adopted by the board.

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective
16 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
17 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
