Relating to the State Board of Pharmacy; to amend Section 34-23-131 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the registration of pharmacy technicians; to delete the time limit for the reinstatement of the lapsed registration of a pharmacy technician without examination by the board and limit the penalties and late fees required to be paid to five years. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 34-23-131 of the Code of Alabama 11 1975, is amended to read as follows:

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"§34-23-131.

"(a) A pharmacy technician shall not perform
pharmacy functions or be present in the prescription
department of a pharmacy unless he or she is under the direct
supervision of a licensed pharmacist. A pharmacy technician
shall not perform pharmacy functions or be present in the
prescription department of a pharmacy unless he or she is
registered by the board.

20 "(b) When supervision is required, a licensed 21 pharmacist shall be jointly responsible and liable for the 22 actions of a pharmacy technician.

"(c) A pharmacy technician shall register and pay a
fee as determined by the board before performing any pharmacy
functions. The board shall develop rules and regulations

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1 relating to the registration of all pharmacy technicians. The 2 registration of a pharmacy technician shall be renewable biennially in odd-numbered years upon payment of the required 3 renewal fee. The registration of each pharmacy technician 4 shall expire on December 31 of odd-numbered years. In order to 5 6 continue to be licensed, each registered pharmacy technician shall pay a biennial renewal fee of not less than twenty 7 8 dollars (\$20), as determined by rule of the board, the fee being due on October 31 and delinquent after December 31 of 9 10 odd-numbered years. The payment of the renewal fee shall 11 entitle the pharmacy technician to renewal of his or her registration at the discretion of the board. If any pharmacy 12 13 technician fails to pay the renewal fee as required by this 14 subsection, he or she may be reinstated as a pharmacy 15 technician only upon payment of a penalty of not less than ten 16 dollars (\$10) nor more than twenty dollars (\$20), as 17 determined by rule of the board, for each lapsed year and all lapsed fees for each lapsed year, provided the lapsed time of 18 registration shall not exceed five years, in which case 19 20 reinstatement may be had only upon satisfactory examination by 21 the board up to a maximum of five years of total penalties and 22 lapsed fees.

"(d) In addition to any other registration
requirements, a pharmacy technician shall complete three hours
of continuing education annually, or six hours biennially, of

which one hour per year shall be live presentation. The board may grant an extension to a pharmacy technician who fails to complete the required continuing education hours in the allotted time. A pharmacy technician who fails to complete the annual continuing education requirements shall be subject to disciplinary action by the board."

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
