BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 11 Section 1. The following amendment to the 12 13 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of 14 15 this act are fulfilled: PROPOSED AMENDMENT 16 "Amendment 508. 17 18 "The operation of bingo games for prizes or money by certain nonprofit organizations for charitable, educational, 19 20 or other lawful purposes shall be legal in Calhoun county, 21 subject to the provisions of any resolution or ordinance by 22 the county governing body or the governing bodies of the 23 respective cities and towns, within their respective 24 jurisdictions as provided by law regulating such operation. 25 The said governing bodies shall have the authority to 26 promulgate rules and regulations for the issuance of permits or licenses and for operation of bingo games, within their 27

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1 respective jurisdictions; provided, however, that said 2 governing bodies must ensure compliance pursuant to said law 3 and the following provisions:

4 "(a) No person under the age of 19 shall be
5 permitted to play any game or games of bingo, unless
6 accompanied by a parent or guardian; nor shall any person
7 under the age of 19 be permitted to conduct or assist in the
8 conduct of any game of bingo;

9 "(b) No bingo permit or license shall be issued to 10 any nonprofit organization, unless such organization shall 11 have been in existence for at least 12 months immediately 12 prior to the issuance of the permit or license;

"(c) Bingo games shall be operated only on the premises owned or leased by the nonprofit organization operating the bingo game. If the premises is leased, the rate or rental shall not be based on a percentage of receipts or profits resulting from the operation of bingo games;

18 "(d) No nonprofit organization shall enter into any 19 contract with any individual, firm, association or corporation 20 to have said individual or entity operate bingo games or 21 concessions on behalf of the nonprofit organization, nor shall 22 said nonprofit organization pay consulting fees to any 23 individual or entity for any services performed in relation to 24 the operation or conduct of a bingo game;

"(e) A nonprofit organization shall not lend its name or allow its identity to be used by any other person or entity in the operating or advertising of a bingo game in

which said nonprofit organization is not directly and solely
 operating said bingo game;

3 "(f) Prizes given by any qualified nonprofit
4 organization for the playing of bingo games shall not exceed
5 the cash amount or gifts of equivalent value, set by the
6 legislature, during any bingo session. The legislature shall
7 set a maximum amount for any calendar week;

8 "(g) No person or organization, by whatever name or 9 composition thereof, shall take any expenses for the operation 10 of a bingo game except as permitted by law.

"(h) No bingo permittee or licensee may operate any bingo game <u>in the unincorporated areas of the county</u> within 1,000 yards of a residence or in a residential area.

14 "The provisions of this constitutional amendment 15 shall be self-executing, but the legislature shall have the 16 right and power by general, special or local act to adopt laws 17 supplemental to this amendment or in furtherance of the 18 general purposes and objectives herein set forth."

19 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 20 shall be held in accordance with Section 284.01 of the 21 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 22 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 23 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 24 state.

25 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 26 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 27 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of 2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Calhoun County; proposing a local 3 constitutional amendment to Amendment 508 of the Constitution 4 5 of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 1 of the Calhoun County Local Amendments of the Official Recompilation of the 6 7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, authorizing the operation of bingo games for prizes or money in the county, to 8 prohibit any bingo permittee or licensee from operating bingo 9 10 within 1,000 yards of a residential area within unincorporated areas of the county. 11
