ENROLLED, An Act,

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Escambia County, to define the Canoe Landmark District within the county and to prohibit the annexation by local law of any property within the district into any municipality except under certain conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

(a) For the purposes of this amendment, the "Canoe Landmark District" in Escambia County is defined as follows:

All of Sections Thirteen (13), Twenty-four (24), Twenty-five (25) and Thirty-six (36) and that portion of Twelve (12) which lies south of Cowpen Creek; in Township one North (T1N), Range Six East (R6E) and Sections Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20), Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30), Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32) and that portion of Sections Seven (7) and Eight (8) which lie south of Cowpen Creek; in Township one North (T1N), Range Seven East (R7E) of Escambia County, Alabama. This Landmark District may be further described as: Beginning at the Northwest (NW)

1 Corner of Section Thirteen (13) of Township One North, Range
2 Six East (T1N, R6E), run South along said Section Lines to the
3 Alabama/Florida State Line which is at the Southwest Corner
4 (SW Cor) of Section Thirty-six (36), thence Run East along the
5 said State Lines to the Southeast Corner (SE Cor) of Section
6 Thirty-two (32) of T1N, R7E, thence run North along the East
7 Boundary of said Section Lines to the Northeast Corner (NE
8 Cor) of Section Seventeen (17) of T1N, R7E, thence run West
9 along the North Boundary of said Section Lines to the
10 intersection of said Section Line and Cowpen Creek, thence
11 follow the meandering of said creek Westerly to the
12 intersection of said creek and Sections Twelve/Thirteen (12
13 and 13) of Township One North, Range Six East (T1N, R6E),
14 thence run West along said Section lines back to the point of
15 beginning.

16 (b) No property within the Canoe Landmark District
17 may be annexed into any municipality by local law.

18 (c) Subsection (b) shall not apply to any
19 municipality incorporated after the ratification of this
20 amendment which includes any part of the Canoe Landmark
21 District.

22 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
23 shall be held at the general election in November 2020 in
24 accordance with Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama
25 of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official

1 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
2 amended, and the election laws of this state.

3 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
4 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
5 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
6 following description of the substance or subject matter of
7 the proposed constitutional amendment:

8 "Relating to Escambia County, proposing an amendment
9 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to define the Canoe
10 Landmark District within the county and to prohibit the
11 annexation by local law of any property within the district
12 into any municipality except under certain conditions.

13 "Proposed by Act _____."

14 This description shall be followed by the following
15 language:
