Relating to the purchasing power of the Department of Corrections; to amend Section 14-7-8, Code of Alabama 1975, as last amended by Act 2018-248, 2018 Regular Session, to authorize the department to promote the department's products and services through advertisements, meals, and other commonly used advertisement methods.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 14-7-8, Code of Alabama 1975, as last amended by Act 2018-248, 2018 Regular Session, is amended to read as follows:

13 "\$14-7-8.

"(a) The Alabama Department of Corrections is authorized to do all of the following:

- "(1) Purchase purchase in the manner prescribed by law, equipment, raw materials, components, services, and supplies.
- "(2) Engage and to engage the supervisory personnel necessary to establish and maintain for this state, at a penitentiary, or a penal farm, or other institution now or hereafter under the control of the department, industries for the utilization of services of prisoners in the manufacture or production of such articles or products as may be needed for the construction, operation, maintenance, or use of any

4	"(3) Promote the department's products and services
5	using any of the following manners:
6	"a. Advertisements.
7	"b. Receptions.
