Section 1. Section 40-18-100, Code of Alabama 1975,
is amended to read as follows:

"§40-18-100.

7 "For the purposes of this article, the following
8 terms shall have the respective following meanings ascribed by
9 this section:

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"(1) CLAIMANT AGENCY. Only Any of the following:

11 "a. The Alabama Commission on Higher Education with 12 respect to the collection of debts under <u>either of the</u> 13 <u>following</u>:

14 "1. The Alabama Student Grant Program provided for
15 by Chapter 33A of Title 16<del>; and.</del>

16 "2. The Alabama Guaranteed Student Loan Program17 provided for by Chapter 33B of Title 16.

18 "b. The Alabama Department of Human Resources with 19 respect to the collection of debts and money owed under any 20 and all of its public assistance programs and other programs 21 administered by that department, including support programs 22 administered pursuant to the requirements of Title IV-D of the 23 Social Security Act.

24 "c. The Alabama Medicaid Agency with respect to the 25 collection of debts and money owed under any and all of the 26 programs it administers. "d. The Alabama Department of Labor with respect to
 the collection or recovery, or both, of debts owed as a result
 of overpayments of state unemployment compensation benefits.

4 "e. The Unified Judicial System with respect to the
5 collection of fines and court costs owed as a result of any
6 court or judicial proceeding.

7 "f. Counties and municipalities acting through an organization as provided in Section 40-18-103, with respect to 8 the collection of any debt owed and finalized by law, 9 10 ordinance, or resolution. For the purposes of this section and Section 40-18-103, counties and municipalities shall include, 11 without limitation, shall include all corporations and other 12 13 instrumentalities whose governing boards are comprised of a majority of members who are appointed or elected by counties 14 15 or municipalities.

16 "g. A housing authority under Chapter 1, Title 24, 17 with respect to the collection of debts and money owed under 18 any and all of the programs administered by the authority.

19 "(2) DEBTOR. Any individual owing money or having a 20 delinquent account with any claimant agency, which obligation 21 has not been adjudicated, satisfied by court order, set aside 22 by court order, or discharged in bankruptcy.

"(3) DEBT. Any liquidated sum due and owing any
claimant agency, including any sum collected on behalf of a
claimant agency pursuant to an agreement authorized by
subdivision (30) of subsection (a) of Section 22-21-318 or
Section 11-62-7, which has accrued through contract,

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subrogation, tort, or operation of law regardless of whether there is an outstanding judgment for that sum, or any liquidated sum of child or spousal support, or both child and spousal support, due and owing any individual eligible for and receiving child support enforcement services through the Alabama Department of Human Resources.

7 "(4) DEPARTMENT. The Department of Revenue of the
8 State of Alabama.

9 "(5) REFUND. The Alabama income tax refund which the 10 department determines to be due any individual taxpayer."

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective 12 immediately following its passage and approval by the 13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
