To provide a subsistence allowance for each full-time law enforcement officer, firefighter, and emergency medical services provider employed by the state, a county, or a municipality; to provide that the subsistence allowance would not be subject to state income tax; to provide exceptions; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Each full-time law enforcement officer, firefighter, and emergency medial services provider employed by the state, a county, or a municipality shall receive a

subsistence allowance of eight dollars (\$8) for each working 1 2 day while engaged in the performance of his or her official 3 duties. This allowance shall be in addition to all other compensation, expenses, and allowances provided by law. 4 5 Section 2. The subsistence allowance provided by this act is not subject to any income tax levied by this 6 7 state. Section 3. This act does not apply to any law enforcement officer receiving a subsistence allowance pursuant 9 10 to Section 36-21-2, Code of Alabama 1975. 11 Section 4. This act shall be effective October 1, 2019, following its passage and approval by the Governor, or 12

its otherwise becoming law.
