"The State Board of Education shall be composed of the Governor as an ex officio member and eight members elected from districts provided by general law. Members of the board shall serve for terms of four years each, and the member from each district shall be elected by the qualified electors of the district at the general election immediately preceding the expiration of the term of office of the member, as designated by the board, representing such district on the board and every four years thereafter. Each member shall hold office from the first Monday after the second Tuesday in January next after his or her election and until his or her successor is elected and qualified. Commencing on the effective date of the act amending this section, a member may not serve more than two four-year terms of office. A member who is serving, or has served, a first or second term of office on the board on or before the effective date of the act amending this section may serve for one additional term of office on the board. A member who is serving, or has served, a third or subsequent term of office on the board on or before the effective date of the act amending this section may not serve for an additional term of office on the board." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
