13A-11-75 shall be eligible to obtain the pistol permit
without paying a fee for the permit as provided in subsection
(a).

10 "(b) (c) Eighty percent of the fees collected shall
11 be deposited into a bank account maintained by the sheriff.
12 The funds shall be used and expended by the sheriff for the
13 employment of personnel, the purchase of equipment, supplies,
14 and materials, and for any other lawful purpose related to law
15 enforcement in the county.

16 "(c) (d) Twenty percent of the fees collected shall
17 be deposited into the Blount County General Fund."
