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2 ENROLLED, An Act, 3 Relating to the Secretary of State; to amend Sections 36-14-1, 36-14-11, 36-14-12, and 36-14-13, Code of 4 Alabama 1975, to authorize the Secretary of State to 5 6 distribute volumes of legislative acts and resolutions and 7 other documents in electronic format; and to provide for notice to all recipients. 8 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. Sections 36-14-1, 36-14-11, 36-14-12, and 10 11 36-14-13, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as 12 follows: "§36-14-1. 13 14 "It is the duty of the Secretary of State: 15 "(1) To keep the state seal, the original statutes 16 and public records of the state, and the records and papers 17 belonging to the Legislature, keeping the papers of each house 18 separate. 19 "(2) To attest commissions and all other public documents from the executive of the state and, when necessary, 20 21 to affix the seal of the state thereto and to certify the same 22 in his or her official capacity. 23 "(3) To record, in books proper for that purpose, 24 all grants and patents issued by the state.

"(4) To keep all books, maps, and other papers
 appertaining to the survey of lands belonging to the state and
 the books and papers belonging to the land office.

4 "(5) To keep in his <u>or her</u> office the books, maps,
5 and field notes of the late surveyor general of the United
6 States for this state which are public archives of the state
7 and, upon application, to give certified copies of the same,
8 which shall be received in evidence in any of the courts of
9 this state.

10 "(6) To certify, on application and the payment of
11 lawful fees, certify copies of all records, grants, papers,
12 and laws of the several states or of the United States.

13 "(7) To make annually, by September 30, a verified 14 and itemized account of all money and fees received in his <u>or</u> 15 <u>her</u> office and of all payments and disbursements made <del>by him</del>, 16 which must be reported to and filed with the Governor, and <del>by</del> 17 <del>him must be</del> transmitted to the next succeeding Legislature.

18 "(8) To give notice to the district attorneys of the 19 respective circuits or counties of all officers who fail to 20 file their bonds in his <u>or her</u> office, or make returns of 21 elections within the time prescribed.

"(9) To procure the acts and resolutions of the
Legislature, of which distribution is directed, to be half
bound and lettered.

1 "(10) To receive from the state printer 10
2 additional copies of all bills, joint resolutions, and
3 memorials printed by order of either house of the Legislature
4 and, on the adjournment of each session of the Legislature, to
5 have one of each of such copies bound together in a cheap form
6 and file them and the copies not bound in his <u>or her</u> office.

"(11) On entering into the contract provided for in 7 8 Section 11-3-25, to furnish to the county commissions, from the records now in his or her office, exact copies of the 9 10 field notes of the original surveys of all the lands in their 11 respective counties, which shall be books of proper size to be supplied by such courts, at the close of which he or she shall 12 13 append his or her certificate as to the correctness thereof 14 under the Great Seal of the State.

15 "(12) To procure from the general land office in
16 Washington, D.C., complete lists of the entries of public
17 lands in Alabama, so as to be enabled to complete the Alabama
18 state tract books in his <u>or her</u> office to date, the expense
19 attending the procurement of which to be paid upon his <u>or her</u>
20 certificate to the Comptroller, or who shall draw a warrant on
21 the Treasurer.

"(13) To procure lists of entries of public lands in
this state annually, so as to comply with the following
subdivision of this section (14), the expense to be paid as
provided in the preceding subdivision (12).

"(14) To enter on the tract books, by October 1 of each year, a list of all the lands (not already so entered) sold by the United States, and to make out and furnish each probate judge, by January 1 of each year, a register or statement showing all the lands so sold in the county of such judge and not embraced in any register or statement previously furnished.

"(15) To file all deeds or leases heretofore given 8 9 or which may be hereafter given conveying real property to the 10 State of Alabama, or any of its departments, agencies, 11 commissions, boards, institutions, or public corporations brought into existence by act of the Legislature, except tax 12 13 sales deeds, in the office of the Secretary of State. The 14 Secretary of State shall promptly record the deeds so filed in 15 his or her office by writing, typewriting, or by photostat, or 16 by electronic format and shall preserve the deeds as recorded 17 in a well-bound book if not stored in electronic format. The Secretary of State shall be required to furnish a certified 18 19 copy of all deeds filed for record in his or her office to any department, agency, commission, board, institution, or public 20 21 corporation created by act of the Legislature, when any such 22 department, agency, commission, board, institution, or public 23 corporation formed or created by act of the Legislature 24 desires a certified copy of such deed.

"(16) To perform such other duties as he <u>or she</u> is
 or may be required by law to perform.

3 "(17) To implement a central filing system that 4 complies with regulations promulgated by the Secretary of the 5 United States Department of Agriculture pertaining to central 6 filing of liens on farm products.

8 "(a) The Secretary of State shall retain for the use of the executive offices and the two houses of the Legislature 9 10 the number of copies of all volumes of the acts and 11 resolutions of each session necessary to provide for distribution pursuant to law. The Secretary of State shall 12 13 transmit to the Department of State of the United States two 14 copies of each volume, and distribute to the Governor, Treasurer, Auditor, Superintendent of Education, Commissioner 15 16 of Agriculture and Industries, State Health Officer, Adjutant 17 General, the Board Department of Corrections, President and each Associate Commissioner of the Public Service Commission, 18 Commissioner of Conservation and Natural Resources, Department 19 20 of Revenue, Clerk of the Supreme Court, Secretary of the 21 Senate and Clerk of the House of Representatives two copies of 22 each volume, to the Attorney General and Secretary of State, 23 three copies, to the Department of Archives and History, five 24 copies, to the Chief Examiner of the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts, 40 copies, and to the President of the 25

1 University of Alabama, for the law department, 8 copies of 2 each volume, and to each judge of the Supreme Court, Court of Civil Appeals, Court of Criminal Appeals, circuit court, 3 district attorney, United States District Judge, and United 4 5 States Attorney in this state one copy of each volume, and to 6 the Supreme Court Library, 11 copies of each volume, and to 7 the Department of Justice of the United States, one copy of 8 each volume, and to the United States Circuit Court of Appeals 9 for the Eleventh Circuit, one copy of each volume, and to the 10 Librarian of Congress at Washington, for the purpose of 11 copyright, two copies of each volume, and to the University of 12 Alabama, for the Land Commissioner, the University of 13 Montevallo, each normal school in the state, Auburn 14 University, and to each district agricultural school in the 15 state, one copy of each volume. Any department, officer, or 16 court named in this section may reduce or refuse the 17 allocation of acts upon written request to the Secretary of 18 State. "(b)(1) In lieu of binding and distributing copies 19

13	" <u>(a)</u> The Secretary of State must also transmit to

17	register of the circuit court, one copy of each volume. The
