ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Talladega County; to require each certified volunteer fire department and any association of volunteer fire departments in the county to have a board of directors; and to provide for the qualification of the board members.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In Talladega County, each volunteer fire department receiving county funds and certified by the Alabama Forestry Commission and any association of volunteer fire departments in the county receiving or disbursing state or local funds shall have a board of directors composed of five members elected by the members of the department or association, as the case may be. Each member of the board shall be a resident and registered voter in the area served by the volunteer fire department or in the case of the association, the county, and shall not be related by blood or marriage to a member of the volunteer fire department or association as a grandparent or grandparent-in-law, mother or father or mother-in-law or father-in-law, brother or sister or brother-in-law or sister-in-law, or child or niece or nephew of a member of the department. Members of the board shall serve a term as provided in the bylaws of the department or association. Any volunteer fire department or the association

2 act shall not be eligible to receive or disburse any county
3 funds.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective
5 immediately following its passage and approval by the
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
