Relating to Talladega County; to require each certified volunteer fire department and any association of volunteer fire departments in the county to have a board of directors; and to provide for the qualification of the board members.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. In Talladega County, each volunteer fire 10 department receiving county funds and certified by the Alabama 11 Forestry Commission and any association of volunteer fire departments in the county receiving or disbursing state or 12 local funds shall have a board of directors composed of five 13 14 members elected by the members of the department or association, as the case may be. Each member of the board 15 16 shall be a resident and registered voter in the area served by 17 the volunteer fire department or in the case of the 18 association, the county, and shall not be related by blood or 19 marriage to a member of the volunteer fire department or 20 association as a grandparent or grandparent-in-law, mother or 21 father or mother-in-law or father-in-law, brother or sister or 22 brother-in-law or sister-in-law, or child or niece or nephew 23 of a member of the department. Members of the board shall 24 serve a term as provided in the bylaws of the department or 25 association. Any volunteer fire department or the association

of volunteer fire departments which fails to comply with this act shall not be eligible to receive or disburse any county funds.

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
