2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3           Relating to Class 2 municipalities; to amend Section  
4 32-13-6, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that any Class 2  
5 municipality that owns and operates an impound facility and  
6 sells abandoned motor vehicles at public auction shall retain  
7 the proceeds from the sale in the general fund of the  
8 municipality.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10           Section 1. Section 32-13-6, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
11 amended to read as follows:

12           "§32-13-6.

13           "A person or entity~~7~~ making the sale of the motor  
14 vehicle shall deduct from the proceeds of the sale the  
15 reasonable cost of repair, towing, storage, and all reasonable  
16 expenses incurred in connection with the sale. The person or  
17 entity shall also pay the balance remaining to the license  
18 plate issuing official of the county in which ~~such~~ the sale is  
19 made to be distributed to the general fund of the county,1  
20 except any Class 2 municipality that owns and operates an  
21 impound facility and sells the motor vehicles at public  
22 auction, the proceeds from the sale shall be retained by the  
23 municipality and deposited into the general fund of the  
24 municipality; provided, that ~~such~~ the costs shall in no event

1 exceed the customary charges for like services in the  
2 community where the sale is made."

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
