Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Effective beginning the next term of office of the Sheriff of Shelby County after the ratification of this amendment, any allowances or other amounts received by the sheriff for feeding prisoners shall be deposited in a separate account in the county treasury to be known as the "Sheriff's Discretionary Fund" and shall be used by the sheriff for the feeding of prisoners in the county jail. Any funds in the Sheriff's Discretionary Fund over the amounts needed for feeding prisoners may be used by the sheriff at his or her discretion only for law enforcement purposes and the sheriff shall not be personally entitled to any portion thereof. Any funds in the Sheriff's Discretionary Fund shall be carried over from year to year. In the event additional amounts are needed by the sheriff for the feeding of prisoners, the amounts shall be paid by the sheriff from any other discretionary funds available for the operation of the office of the sheriff. The sheriff shall not be subject to the competitive bid law for the purchase of food or supplies used for feeding prisoners in the county jail.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Section 284 and Section

284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing 1 2 as Section 284 and Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as 3 amended, and the election laws of this state. 4 5 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 6 7 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 8 following description of the substance or subject matter of 9 the proposed constitutional amendment: 10 "Relating to Shelby County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that 11 effective beginning the next term of office of the sheriff, 12 13 all allowances or amounts received by the sheriff for feeding 14 prisoners would be deposited in a special account and used for 15 feeding prisoners in the county jail and any excess in the fund would be authorized to be used only for law enforcement 16 17 purposes by the sheriff and the sheriff shall not be 18 personally entitled to any portion thereof. "Proposed by Act " 19 20 This description shall be followed by the following 21 language:
