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2	ENROLLED, An Act,
3	Relating to Elmore County; to amend Section
4	45-26-130 of the Code of Alabama 1975, providing for the
5	employment of the county engineer or chief engineer; to
6	further provide that the county engineer or chief engineer may
7	be assigned additional duties by the county commission and may
8	employ, supervise, and direct deputies and assistants to
9	perform the duties.
10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
11	Section 1. Section 45-36-130 of the Code of Alabama
12	1975, is amended to read as follows:
13	"§45-26-130.
14	"(a) This section shall apply only in Elmore County.
15	"(b) The Elmore County Commission shall appoint and
16	employ a county engineer or chief engineer, who shall be a
17	thoroughly qualified and competent professional engineer. The
18	county engineer or chief engineer shall possess all of the
19	qualifications as specified for county engineers or chief
20	engineers under the general laws of the State of Alabama. The
21	county engineer <u>or chief engineer</u> shall devote his or her
22	entire time and attention to be responsible for the
23	maintenance and construction of the public roads, bridges, and
24	ferries in the county and shall perform other duties related
25	to his or her appointment as may be assigned by the county

1	<u>commission</u> . The county engineer <u>or chief engineer</u> shall serve
2	at the pleasure of the county commission.
3	"(c) It shall be the duty of the county engineer <u>or</u>
4	chief engineer to carry out the following as determined by the
5	<u>county commission</u> :
6	"(1) Employ, supervise, and direct all assistants
7	necessary to properly maintain and construct the public roads,
8	bridges, and ferries of the county and prescribe their duties
9	and discharge employees for cause or when they are not needed.
10	"(2) Perform engineering and surveying service as
11	may be required and prepare and maintain the necessary maps
12	and records.
13	"(3) Maintain the necessary accounting records to
14	reflect the cost of the county road system.
15	"(4) Build or construct new roads, or change old
16	roads, but only when ordered to do so by proper order of the
17	county commission.
18	"(5) Construct and maintain all county roads on the
19	basis of the county as a unit without regard to any district
20	or beat lines.
21	"(6) Employ, supervise, and direct any deputies and
22	assistants necessary to assist the county engineer or chief
23	engineer to properly perform all duties of the county engineer
24	<u>or chief engineer.</u>

"(d) It shall be the duty of the county commission to fix, from time to time, in accordance with prevailing economic conditions, the various scales of wages or salaries to be paid for labor necessary in the maintenance and construction of public roads, bridges, and ferries. The wage or salary scale shall not be exceeded by the engineer in employing labor and assistants.

8 "(e) The commission shall fix the amount of the 9 salary of the county engineer <u>or chief engineer</u>, payable in 10 equal monthly installments from appropriate road and bridge 11 funds.

12 "(f) Before entering upon his or her duties, the 13 county engineer or chief engineer shall make and enter into a 14 surety bond in the amount set from time to time by the county 15 commission, payable to Elmore County, conditioned on the faithful discharge and performance of his or her duties as 16 17 engineer, and for the faithful accounting of all monies or property of Elmore County which may come into his or her 18 19 possession or custody. The bond shall be executed by a surety 20 company authorized and qualified to do business in Alabama and 21 shall be approved by the county commission. The premiums shall 22 be paid by the county.

"(g) The county commission shall furnish the county
engineer <u>or chief engineer</u> with an office within the county
and all necessary office supplies, equipment, communication,

1 utilities, and necessary transportation to accomplish his or 2 her duties under this section.

"(h) The county engineer or chief engineer shall be 3 the custodian and accountable to the county commission for all 4 road machinery and equipment, tools, supplies, and repair 5 6 parts owned by Elmore County. The county commission shall 7 establish necessary policies and regulations governing 8 accountability and relief therefrom. The county commission 9 shall furnish the necessary storage and repair facilities for the tools, machinery, supplies, and equipment, and the county 10 11 engineer shall keep on file in his or her office an up-to-date inventory containing a list of all tools, machinery, 12 13 equipment, parts, and supplies owned by the county.

14 "(i) The Unless otherwise determined by the county 15 commission, the authority of the county engineer or chief 16 engineer shall be limited to the expenditure of funds 17 appropriated by the county commission for engineering functions described in this section. The county commission 18 shall fix and determine the amount of funds which will be 19 available for the purpose of building, maintaining, and 20 21 constructing public roads, bridges, and ferries of Elmore 22 County for the ensuing fiscal year, beginning on October 1. 23 That amount, other than the salary of the county engineer or 24 chief engineer, and his or her necessary expenses, shall not 25 be exceeded, except that the county commission, from time to

time, within any period, may increase the amount allowed to be expended by the county engineer <u>or chief engineer</u> during the period, provided that the authorization does not conflict with other provisions of law.

5 "(j) The county engineer <u>or chief engineer</u> shall 6 make written requisition for all materials, machinery, 7 equipment, and necessary supplies needed for the construction, 8 maintenance, or repair of the public roads, bridges, and 9 ferries of the county. The purchases shall be made in 10 accordance with prevailing law.

11 "(k) In the event of an emergency in which it would 12 be impossible for the county commission to employ an engineer, 13 the commission shall employ a competent road supervisor who 14 need not be an engineer, but, when so employed shall have all 15 the duties and authority of the county engineer and shall be 16 subject to this section. The emergency employment of a 17 competent road supervisor shall not continue longer than necessary to employ a qualified engineer who will accept 18 19 employment by the commission under the terms of this section. 20 It is the intention of this section to provide that the 21 construction and maintenance of county roads, bridges, and 22 ferries shall be under the supervision of a qualified 23 engineer.

24 "(1) Each member of the county commission shall25 inspect the roads and bridges of his or her district, from

time to time, hear the suggestions and complaints of the citizens, and report the suggestions or complaints to the county commission with his or her recommendations. The members of the county commission shall also assist in securing right-of-way and assist in public relations generally."

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective 7 immediately following its passage and approval by the 8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
