To amend Section 34-14A-4, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2018-143, 2018 Regular Session, relating to the Home Builders Licensure Board; to require the board to obtain the approval of the Governor and the State Personnel Board when setting the salary of the executive director and the deputy director.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

"\$34-14A-4.

10 Section 1. Section 34-14A-4 of the Code of Alabama 11 1975, as amended by Act 2018-143, 2018 Regular Session, is 12 amended to read as follows:

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14 "(a) Members of the board shall select from its own 15 membership a chair, who shall preside at all meetings of the 16 board unless otherwise ordered, and he or she shall exercise 17 and perform all duties and functions incident to the office of 18 chair. The board may select from its own membership a 19 vice-chair, a secretary, and a treasurer. The offices of 20 secretary and treasurer may be held by the same person.

"(b) The board, at a minimum, shall meet on a quarterly basis and at such other times as the chair may designate for the purpose of transacting business as may properly come before the board. Four members shall constitute a quorum at all meetings. The secretary of the board shall 1 keep such records of each meeting as shall be required by the 2 board.

3 "(c) Members of the board may be compensated in an
4 amount not to exceed three hundred fifty dollars (\$350) per
5 day, not to exceed 15 days per year, for attending meetings of
6 the board or its committees and, in addition, may be
7 reimbursed for such necessary travel expenses as are paid to
8 state employees.

9 "(d) The board may employ an executive director and 10 a deputy director. The board shall have sole authority to, 11 with the approval of the Governor and the State Personnel 12 Board as provided in Section 36-6-6, shall fix the salary of 13 the executive director and the deputy director. The authority 14 to fix the salary of the executive director is not subject to 15 subsection (b) of Section 36-6-6.

16 "(e) The executive director may hire staff to carry 17 out this chapter."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
