4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
5	Section 1. The Victims of Crime and Leniency,
6	Incorporated, is exempted from paying any state, county, and
7	municipal sales and use taxes.
8	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
9	first day of the third month following its passage and
10	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
