14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. The Victims of Crime and Leniency,
16 Incorporated, is exempted from paying any state, county, and
17 municipal sales and use taxes for five years from the
18 effective date of this act.

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
20 first day of the third month following its passage and
21 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
