2 ENROLLED, An Act,

To provide for the zoning authority of municipalities in this state incorporated after 1990 located in a county in which another municipality in the county has zoning authority in its police jurisdiction. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. This act shall apply to all 9 municipalities in this state incorporated after 1990 which are 10 located in a county in which another municipality in that 11 county has zoning authority in its police jurisdiction.

12 Section 2. (a) Any municipality in this state 13 incorporated after 1990, which is located in a county in which 14 another municipality in that county has zoning authority in 15 its police jurisdiction, may divide the territory within its 16 police jurisdiction into business, industrial, and residential 17 zones or districts and, at its option, may provide the kind, character, and use of structures and improvements that may be 18 erected or made within the several zones or districts 19 established and, from time to time, may rearrange or alter the 20 21 boundaries of the zones or districts and may also adopt 22 ordinances as are necessary to implement and administer this 23 act. It is the intent of this act to grant any municipality to 24 which this act applies full zoning authority within its police

jurisdiction to the same extent as the municipality exercises that authority within its corporate limits.

3 (b) This act shall not affect the right of the owner 4 or owners of property located within the police jurisdiction 5 of a municipality to which this act applies to continue to use 6 the property as it is being used on the date of the enactment 7 of any zoning ordinance applicable to the property until the 8 owner or owners of the property seek to change the use of the 9 property.

Section 3. In the event the police jurisdiction of 10 11 any municipality to which this act applies overlaps with the 12 police jurisdiction of another municipality in the county that 13 has zoning authority in its police jurisdiction, the governing 14 body of each municipality may exercise the zoning authority in the overlapping portions of its police jurisdiction to a 15 16 boundary which is equidistant from the respective corporate 17 limits of each municipality that has an overlapping police jurisdiction. Nothing in this section prevents neighboring 18 municipalities from entering into cooperative agreements as to 19 which municipality will exercise zoning authority in the areas 20 21 of overlapping police jurisdiction.

22 Section 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 23 3, in the overlapping areas of the police jurisdiction of the 24 municipalities, each municipality may object to a zoning 25 decision of the other municipality in the overlapping areas.

In that case, the objecting municipality shall notify the other municipality of its objection and the zoning dispute shall be resolved by a panel consisting of the mayors of the two municipalities and the chair of the county commission of the county where the property involved in the zoning dispute is located.

Section 5. Any zoning authority authorized pursuant
to this act shall be undertaken in accordance with Chapter 52
of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975.

10 Section 6. The provisions of this act are severable. 11 If any part of the act is declared invalid or 12 unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part 13 which remains.

Section 7. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

16 Section 8. This act shall become effective 17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 18 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
