- Section 1. (a) A company engaged in termite eradication and control work shall give written notice to a consumer at least 180 days before increasing the price of the consumer's termite protection contract.
 - (b) A company engaged in termite eradication and control work shall give written notice to a consumer at least 180 days before choosing not to renew, or otherwise discontinuing, the consumer's termite protection contract.
 - Section 2. The Commissioner of Agriculture and Industries, with the approval of the State Board of Agriculture and Industries, may adopt rules implementing the terms of this act.
- Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
