Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Etowah County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to amend Amendment 899 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 7.50, Local Amendments, Etowah County, Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, to provide that, with certain exceptions, the employees of the Office of the Sheriff of Etowah County are subject to the jurisdiction of the Personnel Board of Etowah County instead of the Personnel Board of the Office of the
