11 Relating to appellate procedure; to authorize the
12 Speaker of the House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore
13 of the Senate, the Chairs of the House and Senate Judiciary
14 Committees, or the Legislative Council to file a brief of an
15 amicus curiae in an appeal under certain conditions.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 12-1-1, Code of
18 Alabama 1975, or any other provision of Title 12, Code of
19 Alabama 1975, or any rule of the Alabama Rules of Appellate
20 Procedure, the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
21 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Chairs of the House
22 or Senate Judiciary Committees, or the Legislative Council may
23 file a brief of an amicus curiae without leave of court at any
24 time prior to the court's issuance of the certificate of
25 judgment in any appeal. A brief of an amicus curiae, pursuant
26 to this section, shall only be prepared and filed by the staff

1 of the Legislative Services Agency. A brief of an amicus
2 curiae shall only be filed for civil cases.

3 Section 2. It is the intent of the Legislature,
4 pursuant to Section 6.11 of Amendment 328 of the Constitution
5 of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 150 of the
6 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901
7 as amended, that this act supersede any inconsistent rule of
8 appellate procedure adopted by the Alabama Supreme Court.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective
10 immediately following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
