To amend Section 22-8-1, Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the provision of medical or mental health services to a person who is physically or mentally unable to consent under certain conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 22-8-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

10 "\$22-8-1.

"No consent shall be required in order for a licensed physician, psychiatrist, or psychologist, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant to render provide any legally authorized medical or mental health services to a person when said the person is either physically unable to consent or mentally unable to consent and who, but for said the mental or physical disability, would be able to consent and who has no known relatives or legal guardian; provided, that two or more licensed physicians, psychiatrists, or psychologists, or one licensed physician, psychiatrist, or psychologist and one or more nurse practitioners or physician assistants, after having consultation, must indicate, in writing, have signed a written statement finding, in their judgment, that such the medical services are necessary, in their judgment, and any attempt to secure consent from any
