26	Section 1. Sections 32-5B-1 and 32-5B-4, Code of
27	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

1 "§32-5B-1. 2 "This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Alabama Safety Belt Use Act of 1991." Roderick Scott Safety 3 Belt Use Act of 2019. 4 5 "§32-5B-4. "(a) Each front seat occupant of a passenger car 6 7 manufactured with safety belts in compliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 208 shall have a safety belt 8 properly fastened about his or her body at all times when the 9 10 vehicle is in motion. "(b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not 11 12 apply to: 13 "(1) A child passenger under the purview of Section 32-5-222, who is required to use a child passenger restraint 14 15 system or a seat belt pursuant to Section 32-5-222. 16 "(2) An occupant of a passenger car who possesses a 17 written statement from a licensed physician that he or she is 18 unable for medical reasons to wear a safety belt. "(3) A rural letter carrier of the United States 19 20 Postal Service while performing his or her duties as a rural 21 letter carrier. 22 "(4) A driver or passenger delivering newspapers or 23 mail from house to house. 24 "(5) Passengers in a passenger car with model year 25 prior to 1965. 26 "(6) Passengers in motor vehicles which normally operate in reverse." 27

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
