20	Pursuant to and in furtherance of the purposes of
21	this chapter, the State Board of Health is authorized to <u>may</u>
22	create and maintain an immunization registry. The immunization
23	registry is the central collection of data and reports
24	concerning a vaccine dose or doses administered to a person by
25	a provider records on vaccines administered to all ages,
26	including historical records of vaccinations. The nature of
27	the immunization information contained in this registry shall

be determined by rule of the State Board of Health and shall 1 2 be obtained from clinic records, billing data and information, and vital or any other records owned and controlled by the 3 State Board of Health and the Alabama Medicaid Agency. Medical 4 5 insurers and public and private providers are authorized and 6 encouraged to provide information to the registry. In the 7 absence of a bi-directional interface with the registry to 8 send current or retrieve historical records of vaccination 9 administrations, all providers shall review the registry 10 before a vaccine is administered and provide all vaccine data through electronic interface or manual entry in the registry. 11 If the provider is using a bi-directional electronic 12 13 interface, the provider shall review the historical vaccination information provided through that interface before 14 15 a vaccine is administered, and the information for vaccines the provider administers shall be entered into the registry 16 either through the interface or by manual entry into the 17 18 registry. Annual influenza vaccinations shall be reported to the registry, but a review of the registry is not required 19 20 prior to the administration of a vaccine." 21 Section 2. This act shall become effective 22 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 23
