Section 45-25A-40, Code of Alabama 1975, 12 is amended to read as follows: 13 14 "§45-25A-40. 15 "(a) Any law, whether special, local, or general, or 16 municipal ordinance, to the contrary notwithstanding, the City 17 of Fort Payne, in DeKalb County, shall not designate by place number, or by other similar method, seats for city council. 18 19 "(b)(1) In the election for the five members of the city council, the 10 candidates receiving the greatest number 20 21 of votes shall be in a run-off election, conducted and called 22 as now provided by law; the five candidates in the run-off 23 election receiving the greatest number of votes shall be 24 elected to the city council if there are more than five 25 candidates, then the majority of the votes cast for the office

1	in the election shall be determined by dividing the total
2	votes cast for all candidates for the offices by the number of
3	positions to be filled, and then dividing that result by two.
4	Any number of votes in excess of the number determined by the
5	last division shall be the majority necessary for election.
6	"(2) If it appears that any candidate in the
7	election has received a majority of the votes cast for that
8	office, the municipal governing body shall declare that
9	candidate elected to the office, and a certificate of election
10	shall be given to the person by the municipal governing body.
11	" <u>(3) If in determining the results pursuant to this</u>
12	subsection, it appears that more candidates have obtained a
13	majority than there are positions to be filled, then those
14	candidates having the highest vote count, if beyond the
15	majority as defined by subdivision (1), shall be declared
16	elected to fill the positions.
17	"(c)(1) In the election for the members of the city
18	council, if less than five candidates receive a majority as
19	provided by subsection (b), there shall be a run-off election
20	conducted and called as provided by law. The number of
21	candidates that may participate in the run-off election shall
22	be equal to twice the number of positions remaining open, and
23	shall be the candidates with the highest number of votes, but
24	without a majority.

1	"(2) The number of candidates with the highest
2	number of votes in the run-off election equal to the number of
3	remaining positions shall be elected to the city council.
4	" <del>(c)</del> (d)(1) Any Except as provided in subdivision
5	(2), any vacancy in the council which shall exceed $\frac{12}{24}$
6	months shall be filled by special election in the same manner,
7	on a pro rata basis of the number of seats to fill as the
8	original election, for the duration of the term of the
9	predecessor in office; provided, however, that any.
10	" <u>(2)</u> Any vacancy occurring within <del>12</del> <u>24</u> months of
11	the quadrennial council elections in which a mayor is elected,
12	shall be filled by the council by appointment within 30 days
13	of the occurrence of <del>such</del> <u>the</u> vacancy, <u>and</u> the appointee <del>to</del>
14	shall serve out the unexpired term to which he or she is
15	appointed.
16	" <del>(d)</del> <u>(e)(1)</u> The requirements for office, application
17	for candidates, and the fees therefor shall continue to be set
18	by resolution of the city council.
19	" <u>(2)</u> It is expressly provided that all other
20	provisions of law laws and ordinances relating to elections
21	for city council members shall remain effective and except as
22	herein provided, the office of <u>the</u> city council <del>members</del> and
23	the operation of the governing body of Fort Payne, Alabama,
24	shall continue as otherwise provided by law."

1	Section 2. This act shall become effective
2	immediately following its passage and approval by the
3	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
