8 SYNOPSIS: Existing law does not provide that voter
9 qualification appear on Alabama drivers' licenses
10 or nondriver identification cards.

11 This bill would require the Alabama State
12 Law Enforcement Agency to designate the words
13 "registered voter" on the driver's license or
14 nondriver's identification card of each qualified
15 voter.

21 Relating to drivers' licenses and nondriver
22 identification cards; to require the Alabama State Law
23 Enforcement Agency to designate the words "registered voter"
24 on drivers' licenses and nondrivers' identification cards.
25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. (a) Beginning January 1, 2020, in
27 addition to all other content requirements, each driver's

1 license or nondriver identification card issued by the Alabama
2 State Law Enforcement Agency shall display the words
3 "registered voter" on the license or card of each registered
4 voter.

5 (b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may not
6 impose any charge in addition to the driver's license or
7 nondriver identification card fee for the issuance or renewal
8 of a card for displaying the words registered voter.

9 (c) (1) The Secretary of the Alabama State Law
10 Enforcement Agency shall adopt the necessary rules for the
11 issuance of drivers' licenses and nondriver identification
12 cards which designate which persons are registered voters.

13 (2) The Secretary of State shall cooperate with the
14 Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency regarding determinations
15 of valid voter registration.

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
17 first day of the third month following its passage and
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
