Any nominating petition, to be valid, must contain the signatures as well as the addresses of the petitioners. Such certificates and petitions must be filed in the office of the Secretary of State no later than the 82nd
day next preceding the day fixed for the election.

"(c) Each certificate of nomination and nominating 3 petition must be accompanied by a list of the names and 4 5 addresses of persons, who shall be qualified voters of this state, equal in number to the number of presidential electors 6 7 to be chosen as provided in subsection (b) of Section 17-14-30. Each person individual so listed shall execute the 8 9 following statement which shall be attached to the certificate 10 or petition when the same is filed with the Secretary of State: "I do hereby consent and do hereby agree to serve as 11 elector for President and Vice President of the United States, 12 13 if elected to that position, and do hereby agree that, if so 14 elected, I shall cast my ballot as such elector for for President and for Vice President of the United States" 15 16 (inserting in the blank spaces the respective names of the 17 persons named as nominees for the respective offices in the 18 certificate to which this statement is attached) I shall cast 19 my ballot for President and Vice President for the 20 presidential and vice-presidential candidates who received the 21 highest number of votes in the state if I am an at-large presidential elector or the highest number of votes in my 22 congressional district if I am a congressional district 23 24 presidential elector". 25 "§17-14-32. "The names of all candidates for President and Vice 26

27 President who are nominated as provided in this chapter shall

be printed on the official ballots under the emblem of their 1 2 respective political parties, as filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Alabama. The names of the electors of 3 the candidates for President and Vice President shall not be 4 5 printed upon the ballots. A vote for a candidate for President or Vice President shall be counted as a vote for the electors 6 7 of the political party or independent body by which such candidates were named, as listed on the certificate of 8 nomination or nominating petition. 9

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"§17-14-36.

"The electors of President and Vice President are to 11 12 assemble at the office of the Secretary of State, at the seat 13 of government at 12:00 noon on the second Tuesday in December next after their election, or at that hour on such other day 14 15 as may be fixed by Congress, to elect such President and Vice 16 President., and those of them present at that hour must at 17 once proceed by ballot and plurality of votes to supply the 18 places of those who fail to attend on that day and hour. The 19 at-large presidential electors shall cast their ballots for 20 the President and Vice President candidates who received the 21 largest number of votes in the state. The congressional district presidential electors shall cast their ballots for 22 23 the President and Vice President candidates who received the 24 largest number of votes in each respective congressional 25 district."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
