17	Section 1. (a) There is hereby provided for fiscal	
18	year 2019-2020 a funded one-time lump-sum payment, hereinafter	
19	referred to as "lump-sum payment," in the amount of \$400.00 to	
20	each person whose effective date of retirement for purposes of	
21	receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System is	
22	prior to October 1, 2019, and who is receiving or is entitled	
23	to receive a monthly allowance from the Teachers' Retirement	
24	System on September 30, 2019.	
25	(b) Beneficiaries of deceased members or deceased	
26	retirees, if the date of death for the deceased member, or the	
27	effective date of retirement for the deceased retiree for

purposes of receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement System was prior to October 1, 2019, and if the beneficiary is receiving or is entitled to receive a monthly allowance from the Teachers' Retirement System on September 30, 2019, shall receive a lump-sum payment of \$400.00.

6 (c) There is hereby provided for fiscal year 7 2019-2020 a funded one-time lump-sum payment to certain 8 persons identified in subsection (e) herein, whose effective 9 date of retirement for purposes of receiving benefits from the 10 Teachers' Retirement System is prior to October 1, 2019, and 11 who is receiving or is entitled to receive a monthly allowance 12 from the Teachers' Retirement System on September 30, 2019.

13 (d) For purposes of this section, service includes
14 the service under Section 16-25-1 and Section 16-25-150 et
15 seq., Code of Alabama 1975.

(e) Any person who received benefits under the 16 17 Medicaid program and whose eligibility for Medicaid benefits 18 would be impaired by the lump-sum payment provided by this section shall not be entitled to receive the aforementioned 19 20 increase. Any person who subsequently applies for benefits 21 under the Medicaid program and that person's eligibility to 22 receive benefits is impaired by the lump-sum payment provided by this section shall not be entitled to receive the increase 23 24 subsequent to the date that the member files application for 25 benefits under the Medicaid program.

(f) The lump-sum payments provided under this
 section shall be paid to all eligible recipients by the
 Teachers' Retirement System in December 2019.

Section 2. It is not the intent of this act to make
appropriations, but the appropriation required by this act is
conditioned upon the availability of funds in the annual
Education Trust Fund budget act for the fiscal year beginning
October 1, 2019, the recommendation of the Finance Director,
and the approval of the Governor.

10 Section 3. This act shall become effective 11 immediately following its passage and approval by the 12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
