Section 1. Section 41-27-11, Code of Alabama 1975,
is amended to read as follows:
"§41-27-11.
"(a) <del>January 1, 2018, each</del> <u>Each</u> person who applies
for a new driver's license, nondriver identification card, or
vessel license, or a learner's license or permit, or the
renewal of any of the above licenses, cards, or permits, may
provide the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency with
documentation of deafness or autism spectrum disorder. The
information provided in this section shall be stored in the
records of the agency and made available to law enforcement
personnel for use in their official duties.
"(b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may
adopt rules necessary to carry out this section."
Section 2. This act shall become effective January
1, 2020, following its passage and approval by the Governor,

or upon its otherwise becoming law.
