26	"(a) $\underline{(1)}$ In all juvenile, traffic, criminal, and
27	quasi-criminal cases in the juvenile, district, circuit, and

municipal courts in Limestone County, a docket fee, 1 2 hereinafter referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be 3 assessed in each case. The fees, when collected, shall be distributed monthly as follows: 4 5 "a. Three dollars (\$3) from each case, according to the following: 6 7 "1. If the case originates and is disposed of in a 8 circuit court, all three dollars (\$3) to the circuit clerk to 9 be deposited into the circuit clerk's fund. 10 "2. If the case originates and is disposed of in a municipal court, all three dollars (\$3) to the municipal court 11 12 clerk of that municipality, to be deposited into the municipal 13 court clerk's fund or the fund otherwise established for the 14 operation of the office of the municipal court clerk. "3. If the case originates in a municipal court and 15 is disposed of in a circuit court, one dollar (\$1) to the 16 17 circuit clerk to be deposited into the circuit clerk's fund, 18 and two dollars (\$2) to the municipal court clerk of the 19 municipality where the case originated, to be deposited into 20 the municipal court clerk's fund or the fund otherwise

"b. The remainder of each solicitor's fee to the Solicitor's Fund in the county, the district attorney's fund in the county, or to the fund that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the solicitor's fee.

"(2) The solicitor's fee shall be in an amount equal to all docket fees or court costs which are assessed upon an adjudication of guilt in a criminal case and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund. A one dollar (\$1) administrative fee from each case shall be retained by the clerk of court to pay for the operation of the clerk's office. In no event shall the solicitor's fee be less than an amount equal to the Fair Trial Tax Fund docket fees which are prescribed for an adjudication or finding of guilt of the criminal offense charged.

"(b) The solicitor's fee shall be collected in all criminal cases where the defendant is adjudged guilty, a bond forfeited, a penalty imposed, or where there is issued any alias or capias warrant of arrest. The solicitor's fee shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any other fees or costs. The solicitor's fee shall not be waived or remitted unless the defendant proves to the reasonable satisfaction of the sentencing judge that the defendant is not capable of paying the fee within the reasonably foreseeable future.

"(c) The solicitor's fee may be expended by the district attorney for the payment of any and all expenses incurred or for any legitimate law enforcement purpose."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
