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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the mayor of
9 municipalities formed under Chapter 43D, Title 11
10 of the Code of Alabama 1975, manages the municipal
11 public utilities.

12 This bill would remove the management of
13 public utilities from the mayor.

16 TO BE ENTITLED
17 AN ACT
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19 To amend Section 11-43D-14, Code of Alabama 1975,
20 relating to certain Class 5 municipalities; to delete the
21 provision for the management of public utilities by the mayor.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. Section 11-43D-14 of the Code of Alabama
24 1975, is amended to read as follows:

25 "§11-43D-14.

26 "The mayor shall be the chief executive officer, and
27 shall have general supervision and control of all other

1 officers, employees, and affairs of the city, which shall
2 specifically not include the management of the public
3 ~~utilities, either owned and operated by the city or operated~~
4 ~~by private corporations under contracts with the city.~~ The
5 general law applicable to mayor-council municipalities
6 notwithstanding, and except as provided above, the mayor shall
7 have the power to appoint all officers and employees of the
8 city subject to the rules and regulations of any civil service
9 or merit system that may be applicable to ~~said~~ the city. The
10 mayor may remove any person appointed by him or her subject to
11 the rules and regulations of any civil service or merit system
12 that may be applicable to ~~said~~ the city."

13 Section 2. This act shall become effective upon the
14 commencement of the next term of office of the city council in
15 any municipality formed under Chapter 43D, Title 11 of the
16 Code of Alabama 1975.
