(2) When the sheriff is incompetent to act.

(3) When the sheriff is imprisoned.

12 (4) In any case in which the sheriff is a party.

13 (5) In any case when he or she is directed by the14 judge of probate.

Section 2. Section 11-5-5 of the Code of Alabama 16 1975, relating to the county coroner serving as sheriff under 17 certain conditions, is repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
