"f. Nine members, to be appointed by the Governor 1 for terms concurrent with the term of the Governor. Of the 2 members appointed by the Governor, one shall be a 3 representative of business, one shall be a representative of 4 5 labor, one shall be a representative of the medical profession, three shall be representatives of senior citizen 6 7 organizations, and the remaining three shall be responsible citizens of the state. 8

"(2) Upon reappointment, The appointing authorities shall coordinate their appointments to ensure that the membership of the board shall be is inclusive and reflect reflects the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
