13	Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited
14	as Caleb's Law.
15	Section 2. Section 26-10A-30, Code of Alabama 1975,
16	is amended to read as follows:
17	"\$26-10A-30.
18	"(a) Post-adoption visitation rights for the natural
19	grandparents of the adoptee may be granted when the adoptee is
20	adopted by a stepparent, a grandfather, a grandmother, a
21	brother, a half-brother, a sister, a half-sister, an aunt or
22	an uncle and their respective spouses, if any. Such $\underline{\text{The}}$
23	visitation rights may be maintained or granted at the
24	discretion of the court at any time prior to or after the
25	final order of adoption is entered upon petition by the
26	natural grandparents, if it is in the best interest of the
27	child.

1	"(b) Post-adoption rights to visitation, contact, or
2	communication may be granted between an adoptive child and his
3	or her biological siblings when all of the following
4	<pre>conditions are met:</pre>
5	"(1) The prospective adoptive parents agree to the
6	visitation, contact, or communication and the agreement is
7	expressed in writing to the probate court.
8	"(2) The legal parents or legal guardians of the
9	biological siblings consent to the agreement in an affidavit
10	that is submitted to the probate court.
11	"(3) The probate court determines that the
12	visitation, contact, or communication is in the best interest
13	of the adoptive child."
14	Section 3. This act shall become effective
15	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
16	its otherwise becoming law.
