3 AN ACT

Relating to mental health; to establish the position of community mental health counselor for the purpose of providing counseling, support programs, or equivalent services to educational institutions, including K-12 public schools, public community colleges, or public institutions of higher education; to require the State Board of Education, the Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community College System, and the Alabama Commission on Higher Education to adopt rules pertaining to required qualifications for individuals wishing to work as community mental health counselors in their respective educational institutions; and to provide for qualified immunity for a community mental health counselor and for nonprofit organizations that sponsor them.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act, the term "community mental health counselor" means a person who works as a volunteer for or is regularly employed by a nonprofit organization to provide counseling, support programs, or equivalent services to educational institutions, including K-12 public schools, public community colleges, or public institutions of higher education.

(b) A public K-12 school, a community or technical college, or a public institute of higher education may use the

services of a community mental health counselor to the extent allowable under rules adopted pursuant to Section 2.

- (c) A community mental health counselor is not civilly liable for damages as a result of his or her acts or omissions in fulfilling his or her work-related duties, unless the act or omission was the result of his or her unreasonable, intentional, or willful or wanton misconduct.
- (d) A nonprofit organization sponsoring a community mental health counselor is not civilly liable for damages as a result of acts or omissions of a sponsored community mental health counselor in fulfilling his or her work-related duties, unless the act or omission was the result of his or her unreasonable, intentional, or willful or wanton misconduct.
- Section 2. (a) (1) The State Board of Education shall, in collaboration with the Department of Mental Health, adopt rules pertaining to guidelines for the operation of community mental health counselors within public K-12 schools.
- (2) The State Board of Education shall design and provide to local boards of education an application form template for use by nonprofit organizations that wish to provide the services of sponsored community mental health counselors in public K-12 schools.
- (b) (1) The Board of Trustees of the Alabama

  Community College System shall, in collaboration with the

  Department of Mental Health, adopt rules pertaining to

  guidelines for the operation of community mental health

- (2) The Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community College System shall design and provide to community and technical colleges of the state an application form template for use by nonprofit organizations that wish to provide the services of sponsored community mental health counselors in community and technical colleges of the state.
- (c) (1) The Alabama Commission on Higher Education shall, in collaboration with the Department of Mental Health, adopt rules pertaining to guidelines for the operation of community mental health counselors within public institutions of higher education.
- (2) The Alabama Commission on Higher Education shall design and provide to public institutions of higher education an application form template for use by nonprofit organizations that wish to provide the services of sponsored community mental health counselors in public institutions of higher education.

Section 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed to set any licensure requirements for individuals wishing to work as a community mental health counselor.

Section 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that constitutionally created boards of trustees comply with the requirements of this act.

Section 5. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
