27	RE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALARAMA.

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, a governmental agency is an executive, legislative, or judicial agency, department, board, commission, authority, institution, or instrumentality of state government.

- (b) On or before the 15th day of each month, each governmental agency shall submit to the Chairs of the Senate Finance and Taxation General Fund Committee, Senate Finance and Taxation Education Committee, House Ways and Means General Fund Committee, and House Ways and Means Education Committee, a detailed summary of total overtime hours worked and total overtime compensation paid to agency employees by the governmental agency during the immediately preceding month.
- (c) Each governmental agency shall publish on its public website, in a convenient and prominent location, a copy of each monthly summary required in subsection (b). The summaries on the public website shall be searchable by month.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
