| 19 | Section 1. Any provision of the Students First Act |

| 21 | contrary notwithstanding, the following shall apply to |
| 22 | community and technical colleges: |
| 23 | (1) Any faculty or staff member hired before June 1, |
| 24 | 2020, shall remain subject to the Students First Act of 2011. |
| 25 | (2) Any faculty of staff member hired on or after |
| 26 | June 1, 2020, shall be subject to policies adopted by the |
| 27 | Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community College System |

pursuant to Section 16-60-111.4, Code of Alabama 1975, in lieu of the Students First Act of 2011. The policies shall provide for tenure, discipline, termination, transfer, reassignment, reductions-in-force, and other personnel actions as determined by the board.

6 (3) The policies to be adopted shall provide for due 7 process rights to all employees hired after August 1, 2020, 8 who attain and retain tenure or non-probationary status under 9 ACCS policies, and who are noticed for termination for any 10 reason other than reduction-in-force; provided, however that any such due process rights will not be afforded to 11 Presidents, Vice-Presidents or Chief Financial Officers, 12 13 however titled. Such due process shall include an appellate 14 procedure before a neutral decision maker appointed by the 15 Chancellor.

Section 2. Sections 16-60-111.4 and 16-60-111.7 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows: "\$16-60-111.4.

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"(a) The board shall be authorized to:

"(1) Make rules and regulations for the governmentof community and technical colleges.

"(2) Prescribe for the community and technical
colleges the courses of study to be offered and the conditions
for granting certificates, diplomas, and degrees.

"(3) Appoint or terminate the employment of thepresidents of the community and technical colleges.

"(4) Direct the expenditure of legislative 1 2 appropriations of community and technical colleges including, but not limited to, the allocation of the annual legislative 3 appropriation, as the board determines is in the best 4 5 interests of the Alabama Community College System. "(5) Prescribe gualifications for faculty and 6 7 establish, publish, and maintain an annual salary schedule for each community and technical college employee classification 8 and tenure requirements for faculty at community and technical 9 10 colleges. "(6) Before June 1, 2020, estab<u>lish comprehensive</u> 11 policies relating to tenure, discipline, termination, 12 13 transfer, reassignment, reductions-in-force, and other 14 personnel actions as determined by the board. These policies 15 shall apply to faculty and staff hired on or after June 1, 2020, in lieu of the Students First Act of 2011. 16 "(6)(7) Accept gifts, donations, and devises and 17 18 bequests of money and real and personal property for the benefit of community and technical colleges or any one of 19 20 them. 21 "(7)(8) Establish a performance-based allocation 22 process that is equitable and compatible with the services and programs offered by each individual campus. 23 24 "(b) Any provision of law to the contrary 25 notwithstanding, employees of the Alabama Community College System shall participate in the Teachers' Retirement System of 26 Alabama pursuant to Chapter 25 and the State Employee's Health 27

Insurance Plan pursuant to Chapter 29, Title 36. Employees of community and technical colleges shall participate in the Teachers' Retirement System of Alabama pursuant to Chapter 25 and the Public Education Employees' Health Insurance Plan pursuant to Chapter 25A or other qualified health plans established pursuant to Section 1311 of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010.

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"§16-60-111.7.

9 "The Subject to Section 1 of the act adding this 10 <u>amendatory language</u>, presidents of the community and technical 11 colleges shall appoint the faculty and staff of the community 12 and technical colleges according to qualifications prescribed 13 by the board and such other regulations which may be adopted 14 by the board."

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
