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2 ENROLLED, An Act, 3 To amend Section 17-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended by Act 2019-439, 2019 Regular Session, relating to 4 5 meeting days of boards of registrars; to increase the number 6 of working days that the Coffee County Board of Registrars may meet each fiscal year. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 8 Section 1. Section 17-3-8, Code of Alabama 1975, as 9 amended by Act 2019-439, 2019 Regular Session, is amended to 10 11 read as follows: "§17-3-8. 12 "(a) Each member of the board of registrars in the 13 14 Counties of Clay, Cleburne, Coosa, Dallas, Escambia, Geneva, 15 Lowndes, Perry, Sumter, and Wilcox may meet a maximum of 120 16 working days each fiscal year; each member of the board of 17 registrars in the Counties of Barbour, Blount, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Lee, Marengo, Pickens, Pike, Randolph, and 18 Winston may meet a maximum of 168 working days each fiscal 19 year, except in the Counties of Lee and Pike each board of 20 21 registrars may meet up to an additional 30 session days each 22 fiscal year, at the discretion of the chair of the county 23 commission, and such days shall be paid from the respective 24 county funds; each member of the board of registrars in the 25 Counties of Coffee, Talladega, and Tallapoosa County and each

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1 member of the board of registrars in Talladega County may meet 2 a maximum of 220 working days each fiscal year, except that in Talladega County the board of registrars may meet up to an 3 additional 30 session days each fiscal year, at the discretion 4 of the chair of the county commission; each member of the 5 6 board of registrars in the Counties of Dale, Franklin, 7 Houston, Marion, Marshall, Bullock, Macon, and Tuscaloosa may 8 meet a maximum of 216 working days each fiscal year; each member of the board of registrars in the Counties of Limestone 9 10 and Shelby may meet a maximum of 167 working days each fiscal 11 year; and each member of the board of registrars in Russell County may meet a maximum of 177 working days each fiscal 12 13 year.

14 "(b) In the Counties of Choctaw, Coffee, Colbert, 15 Cullman, Lauderdale, and Monroe, each member of the board of 16 registrars may meet a maximum of 199 working days each fiscal 17 year.

"(c) Each member of the Board of Registrars of 18 19 Autauga, Elmore, and Bibb Counties may meet a maximum of 187 20 working days each fiscal year. Each member of the Board of 21 Registrars of Walker County may meet a maximum of 200 days 22 each fiscal year, and each member of the Board of Registrars 23 of Lamar, Cherokee, Clarke, Conecuh, Crenshaw, Hale, and 24 Washington Counties may meet a maximum of 140 days each fiscal 25 year. Each member of the board of registrars in the following

counties may meet the following maximum number of working days each fiscal year: Henry - 140 working days; Covington - 188 working days; DeKalb - 207 working days; Jackson - 207 working days; Etowah - 207 working days; Chambers - 180 working days; and Lawrence - 140 working days.

6 "(d) Each member of the board of registrars in the 7 Counties of Baldwin, Calhoun, Chilton, Madison, Mobile, 8 Montgomery, St. Clair, and Morgan are authorized to meet not 9 more than five days each week for the purpose of carrying out their official duties. Jefferson County, which is now 10 11 operating under the provisions of local laws, shall be exempted from the provisions of this section. Provided, 12 however, that where the words "each year" are used in the 13 14 local laws the words mean "each fiscal year."

"(e) The actual number of working days to be used as session days shall be determined by a quorum of the board of registrars according to the needs of the county.

"(f) As many as 25 of the allotted working days may 18 19 be used for special registration sessions (i.e., those sessions held away from the courthouse in the several 20 21 precincts of the county or sessions held on Saturday or 22 between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.). Notice of any 23 special session scheduled by the board shall be given at least 24 10 days prior to the special session by: (1) Bills posted at 25 three or more public places in each election precinct

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affected, if the session involves precinct visits; and (2) advertisement once a week for two successive weeks in a newspaper published in the county or by radio or television announcements on a local station, or both by newspaper or announcement."

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 7 first day of the third month following its passage and 8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
